# **Accessibility Policy 2018**

This Accessibility Policy and Plan are drawn up in compliance with current legislation and requirements as specified in schedule 10, relating to Disability of the Equality Act 2010. School Governors are accountable for ensuring the implementation, review and reporting on progress of the Accessibility Plan from January 2017- December 2020

- We are committed to providing an accessible environment which values and includes all pupils, staff, parents and visitors regardless of their education, physical, sensory, social, spiritual, emotional and cultural needs. We are committed to challenging negative attitudes about disability and accessibility and to developing a cultural awareness, tolerance and inclusion.
- 2. Princethorpe Infants School plans, over time, to ensure the accessibility of provision for all pupils, staff and visitors to the school.
- 3. An Accessibility Plan will be drawn up to cover a three year period and will be updated each vear.
- 4. The Accessibility Plan will contain relevant actions to :
  - Improve access to the physical environment of the school, adding specialist facilities as necessary. This covers reasonable adjustments to the physical environment of the school and physical aids to access education.
  - Increase access to the curriculum for pupils with a disability, expanding and making
    reasonable adjustments to the curriculum as necessary to ensure pupils with a
    disability are as equally prepared for life as are able-bodied pupils; (If a school fails
    to do this they are in breach of the Disability Discrimination Act). This covers
    teaching and learning and the wider curriculum of the school such as participation in
    after-school clubs, leisure and cultural activities or educational trips. It also covers
    the provision of specialist aids and equipment, which may assist pupils in accessing
    the curriculum.
  - Improve and make reasonable adjustment to the delivery of written information to the pupils, staff, parents and visitors with disabilities. Examples might include handouts, timetables, textbooks and information about the school and school events. The information should be made available in various preferred formats within a reasonable timeframe.
- 5. The Action Plan for physical accessibility relates to the Access Audit of the School, which is undertaken regularly by the Building Site Supervisor and School Business Manager. The audit will need to be revisited prior to the end of each first three-year plan period in order to inform the development of the new plan for the following period.
- We acknowledge that there is a need for on-going awareness raising and training for staff and governors in the matter of disability discrimination and the need to inform attitudes on this matter.
